Background Information

Waikato Hospital would like to bring the visual and performing arts more into the fabric of our hospital. We have been gifted a digital keyboard and would like to maximise its use by having volunteers play regularly in some of our more public spaces i.e. – foyer areas at entrance points and in wards.

Purpose of the Position

- To provide background music, using a digital keyboard, in a variety of public spaces at Waikato Hospital.

Key Tasks of the Volunteer are:-

- Assist with the set-up of the keyboard in foyer area
- Provide appropriate background musical performance
- Assist with the return of equipment to ensure its safety and security
- Time commitment for this position is ideally a fortnightly rostered time of 2 hours Mon. – Fri, between the hours of 10.00am – 2.00pm.

Expectations – it is expected that Volunteers will:-

- Be polite at all times and treat members of the public, patients and staff with dignity, courtesy and consideration
- Assist patients and visitors in a manner that ensures their safety and comfort at all times
- Respect people's right to privacy at all times
- Ask for assistance from staff and refer all problems to the Volunteer Manager when required
- Communicate with and follow the direction/guidance of staff
- Provide feedback as required on tasks undertaken
- Report accidents or incidents immediately
- Comply with the requirements of WDHB policies
- Comply with the required Volunteer dress code
- Bring any ideas, concerns or issues to the Volunteer Manager for discussion
